

PROGRAM DEFINITIONS

FATHERHOOD- InsideOut Dad, is the only evidence based program specifically designed to connect incarcerated fathers to their children while they are on the inside and prepares them for reentry when they get out. Research indicates that when inmates are connected to their family prior to release, they are less likely to return to prison. InsideOut Dad has been proven to increase family contact and develop pro-fathering knowledge, attitudes, and skills.

The Foster Grandparent Program engages seniors in meaningful volunteer service, supporting children and youth in their communities. Through ongoing training and support, foster grandparents improve their skills, health awareness, and engagement, while fostering community stability and partnerships.

The Help At Home non-medical, in-home support services aimed at helping individuals (often older adults or those with disabilities) maintain independence and remain safely in their own homes. Help At Home generally include tasks like light housekeeping, meal preparation, grocery shopping, laundry, errands, personal care and respite. Help At Home serves people aged 60+, adults with physical limitations or disabilities, who cannot perform activities of daily living.

Misdemeanor Probation is a program that provides supervision along with rehabilitative and educational services to misdemeanor offenders in McNairy County(25th Judicial District). It is our goal to provide the best environment and tools to our offenders to ensure the highest probability of success for re-entry into society.

Senior Services Community Employment Program is a federally funded job training program for low-income, unemployed older adults who are 55 and older. Participants gain on-the-job experience with local nonprofits and public agencies to prepare for unsubsidized employment.

TECH Goes Home target audience is senior adults (60+) and disabled adults who are homebound.
